German Foundation for Crime Prevention and Offender Support (GFCP)

The German Foundation for Crime Prevention and Offender Support (“Deutsche Stiftung für Verbrechensverhütung und Straffälligenhilfe”) was initiated in 1989/1990 by Hans-Jürgen KERNER and Erich MARKS

The legal structure of the GFCP is a foundation under the German Civil Code

The endowment funds for the GFCP was given by a 1990 dissolved national German association for offenders Aid (“Bundesverband der Straffälligenhilfe”)

In 1995 the GFCP organized together with various partners the 1. German Congress on Crime Prevention - GCOCP

- since 1995 an (inter-) national annual congress
- 100 speaker and 150 organizations as exhibition partners
- ~ 50 organization as co-operation partner
- sections: lectures, forums, exhibition, congress-university, events, etc.
- 2008: 4.100 participants and guest,
incl. 73 international participants from 33 countries

- ✓ Discussing implementation strategies
- ✓ Developing and disseminating recommendations for practice, politics, administration and research in the field of crime prevention

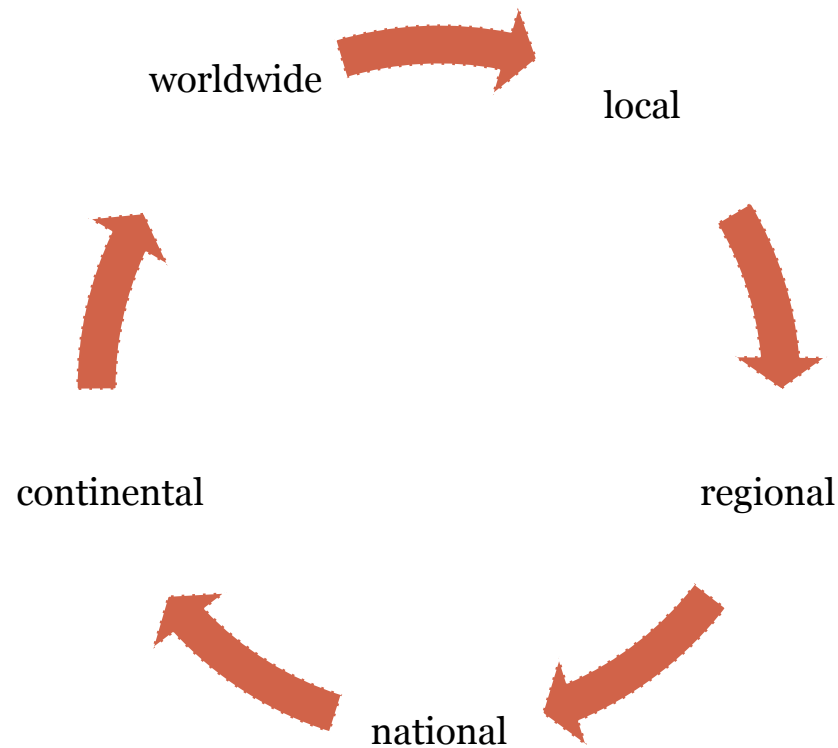

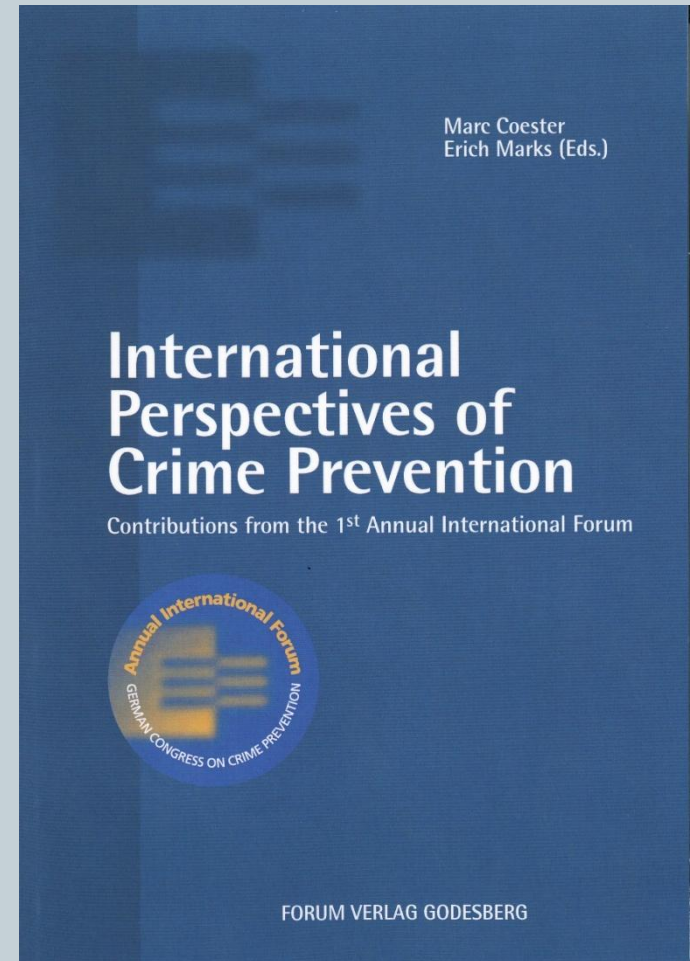
