Konferenzen und Manifeste

All fünf bis sechs Jahre organisiert EFUS eine große Konferenz mit dem Ziel, die aktuellen Debatten und Diskussionen zum Thema urbane Sicherheit in Europa zusammenzuführen. Im Vorfeld werden zu aktuellen Themen in einem partizipativen Prozess Empfehlungen aus den Kommunen erarbeitet, die dann mit den aktuellen Ergebnissen der Konferenz in ein Manifest fließen. Das Manifest legt die großen strategischen Arbeitslinien von EFUS fest und richtet zugleich Forderungen und Empfehlungen an die Politik in den europäischen Einzelstaaten und an die EU. Aktuell ist das Manifest von Aubervilliers und Saint Denis gültig.

Im November 2017 wurde in Barcelona das neue Manifest verabschiedet und knüpft an die Manifeste von [Saint-Dennis \(2012\)](#), Zaragossa (2006) und Neapel (2000) an. Das Manifest von Barcelona ist die inhaltliche und politische Grundlage der Zusammenarbeit der Efus-Mitglieder. Es versammelt Empfehlungen und Willensbekundungen der Mitgliedsstädte zu einem breiten Spektrum von Schwerpunktthemen der Kriminalprävention.

Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice

UNODC has the mission of making the world safer from crime, drugs, and terrorism. To be effective and sustainable, responses to these threats must include strategies covering the following areas:

- **Crime Prevention**, especially Urban crime prevention; Armed violence prevention; Prevention of recidivism
- **Criminal Justice Reform**: Police reform, Prosecution service, Judiciary (the courts), Access to legal defence and legal aid, Prison reform and alternatives to imprisonment, and Restorative justice
- **Justice for children; Support and assistance to victims; Gender in the criminal justice system**

Crime prevention and criminal justice strategies must take a human rights approach and be based on the rules of law, together with the [UN standards and norms in crime prevention and criminal justice](#).



The “DPT-Map” website searches specifically for projects, activities, institutions and persons in the field of crime prevention. This search for keywords is based on thematic databases published already in the internet by recognized specialized organizations.

At the start of www.dpt-map.de in October 2010, 2462 datasets could be searched, based on the websites of the German Congress on Crime Prevention (Deutscher Präventionstag – DPT) and the Crime Prevention Council of Lower Saxony (Landespräventionsrat Niedersachsen). As of October 20, 2018, 30962 datasets are available.
